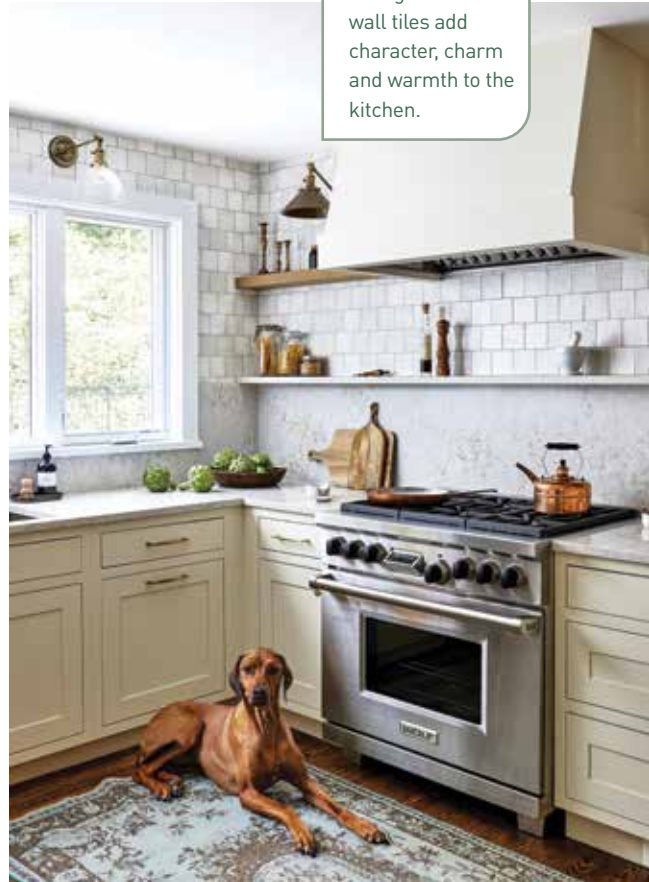
JUST THE TWO OF US
